#### **Public Hearing to Allow Farmer's Markets in Hawthorne**

The Hawthorne Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to consider amending the Hawthorne Municipal Code to allow Farmer's Markets in Hawthorne, subject to a Community Events Permit.

## **Sign up for Hawthorne Police Department Citizen's Academy**

The Hawthorne Police Department is now accepting applications for Hawthorne residents to participate in the next Citizen's Academy class, which is scheduled to begin August 5. The Citizen's Academy provides community members an inside look at police work and law enforcement, covering topics such as identity theft, sex offenders, traffic operations, criminal law, investigations, patrol procedures, communications, gangs, drug enforcement and more. The course also includes a ride along with a police officer.

Classes will be held on Wednesday evenings from 6:00pm – 9:00pm for 10 weeks and are limited to 25 students. Interested candidates must fill out and submit an application, be at least 21, live or work in Hawthorne, and not have any felony convictions or misdemeanor arrests. 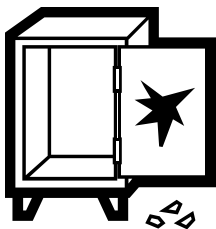
## **HHA Member Opinion Poll - Farmers Market**

Around 2002 / 2003, Dana Middle School proposed creating a Farmer's Market in our community to raise funds to support school programs. At that time, the HHA surveyed the Hollyglen community and found many people were excited about having a Farmers Market close to home. Unfortunately, that project did not come to fruition.

Now in 2009, The Del Aire Neighborhood Association has reached out to the Wiseburn School District and the HHA to relocate the existing Del Aire Farmers Market from Del Aire Park to Aviation & 135<sup>th</sup>. Bringing the market to Aviation & 135<sup>th</sup> will require amendments to the City of Hawthorne code and permits from the City of Hawthorne. If approved, it is proposed that the Hawthorne / Del Aire Farmers Market would be held on Saturday mornings from 9:00am – 1:00pm in the old Dana School parking lot.

The Hollyglen Homeowners Association wants to hear what Hollyglen residents think about having a Farmers Market at Aviation & 135<sup>th</sup>. 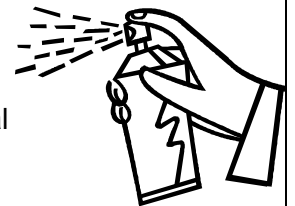
### **NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH**

## Update on 405 Freeway Soundwall

During the first quarter of 2009, Caltrans measured noise levels in Hollyglen and determined that the southbound I-405 between El Segundo Boulevard and Rosecrans Avenue qualifies for a soundwall. Hollyglen has now been added to the POST 1989 Soundwall Project List; however, there are currently \$2 billion in approved projects already on the list that are still waiting for funding, so it may be many years before funding becomes available to build a soundwall for Hollyglen.
