Road Construction Alert – Isis and Rosecrans

Please be advised there will be construction activity within the next 2-3 weeks to install a pipeline on Isis from 141st Street to Rosecrans, on Isis south of Rosecrans, and on Rosecrans from Isis to Aviation. Traffic will be affected by lane closures on Isis and Rosecrans, so please take an alternate route if possible. Signs will be posted to advise motorists of the lane closures.

Dana School Construction

The Wiseburn School District is pleased to report that construction of the new Dana Middle School in Hollyglen is slightly ahead of schedule and under budget. If we don't have significant rain delays, the new Dana School is scheduled to open in the fall of 2007. The project is now 45% complete and there has been only a small amount of change orders to date, well under the amount budgeted. This is exceptional and we are very pleased with the work of our Construction Managers.

The entrance to the new Dana Middle school will be on 135th street. The school is about 83,000 square feet in size and includes a multi-purpose center, science labs, gymnasium, thirty classrooms, library/media center and school administrative/support offices. The latest technology will be incorporated throughout the site.
