Update on New Gated Community "360 at South Bay" Construction

Construction of the new gated housing community on the former LA Air Force Base property at the corner of El Segundo and Aviation boulevards is proceeding on schedule. The grading is completed and utilities are being installed. Construction of the models is scheduled to begin next month, and the models will open in the fall. A temporary information center will be opening this spring. The street improvements on Aviation and El Segundo boulevards are estimated to start as early as March and be completed in summer 2007.

Update on Pipeline & Monitoring Well Installation on Rosecrans and Isis Avenue

Installation of the pipeline and monitoring wells on Rosecrans and on Isis is almost complete. After the city repaves the streets, the contractor will install covers to make the well vaults even with the final road surface.
